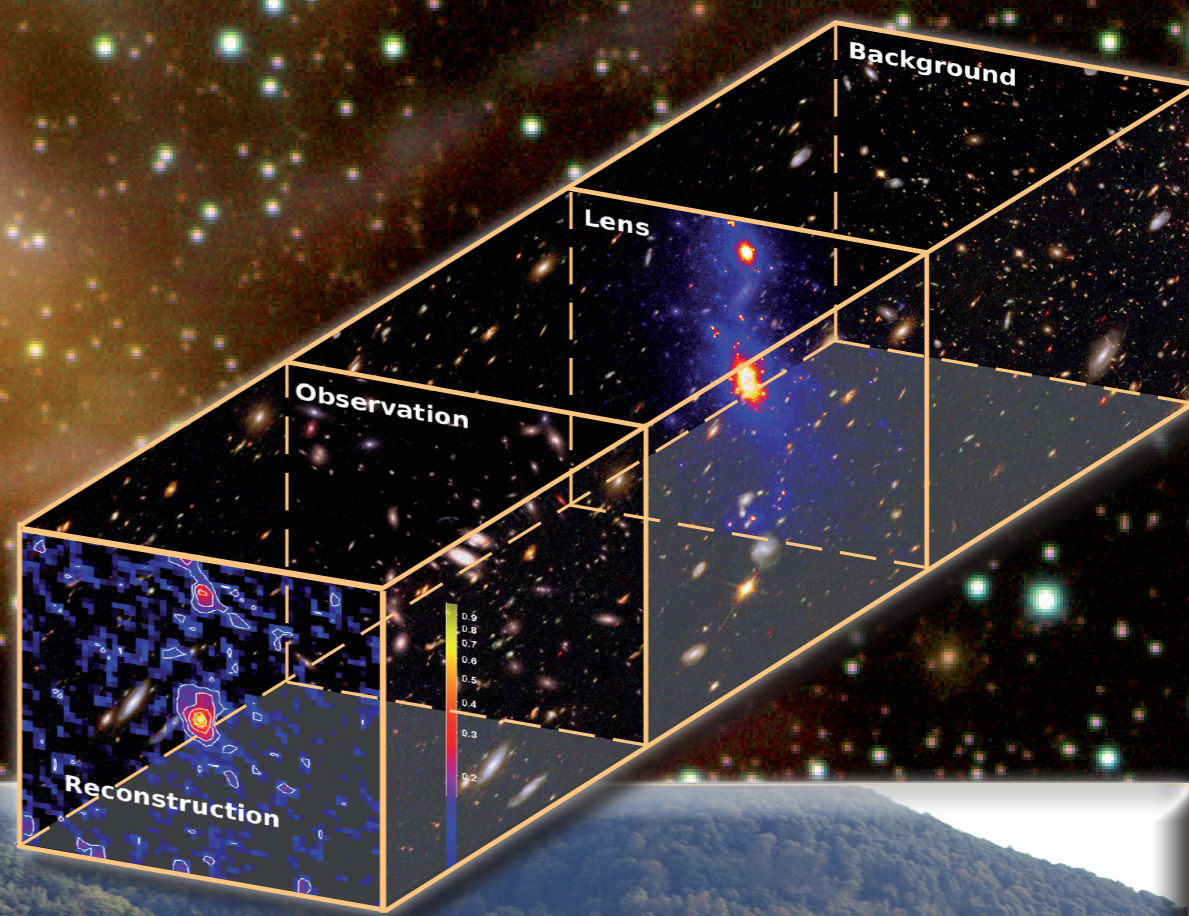
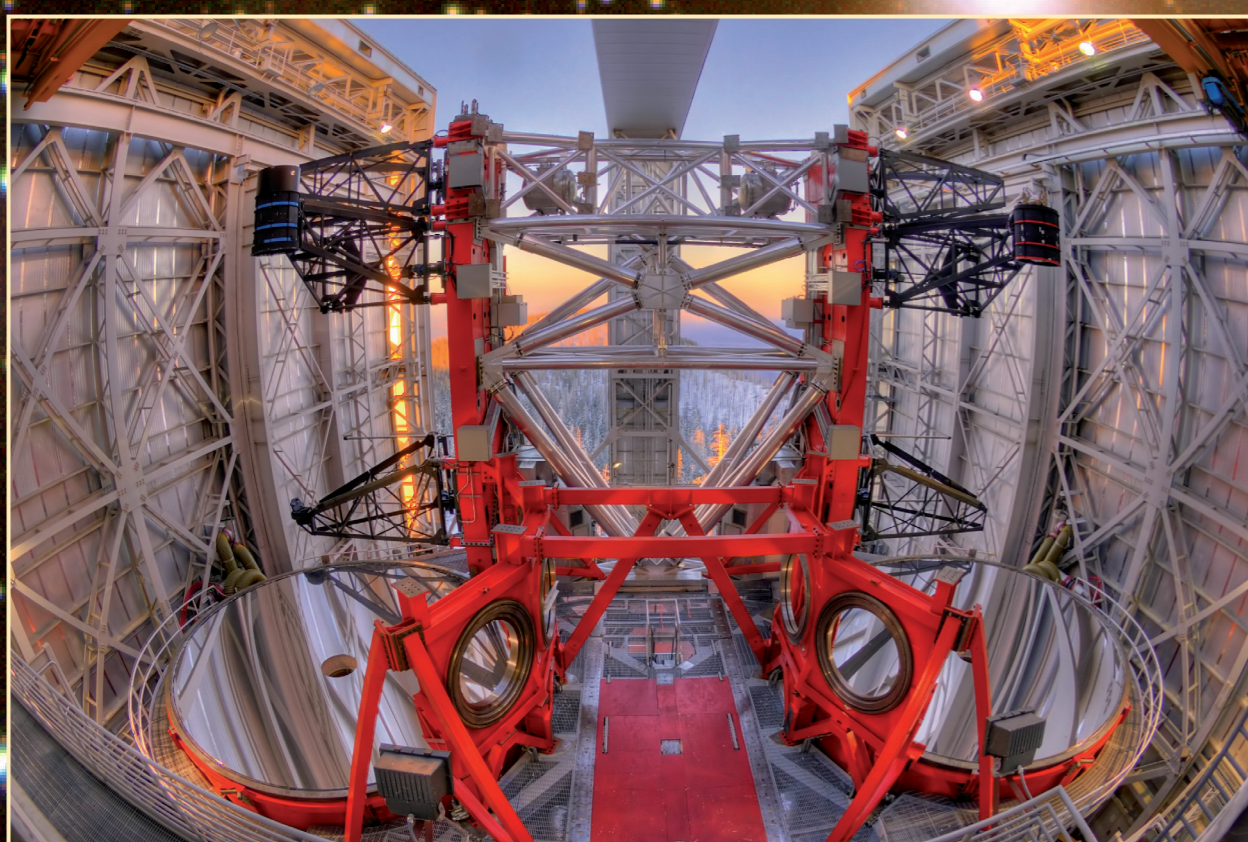


We provide excellent research and training facilities on a wide range of up-to-date research topics in order to prepare for a successful career in astronomy, astrophysics or space science.
