

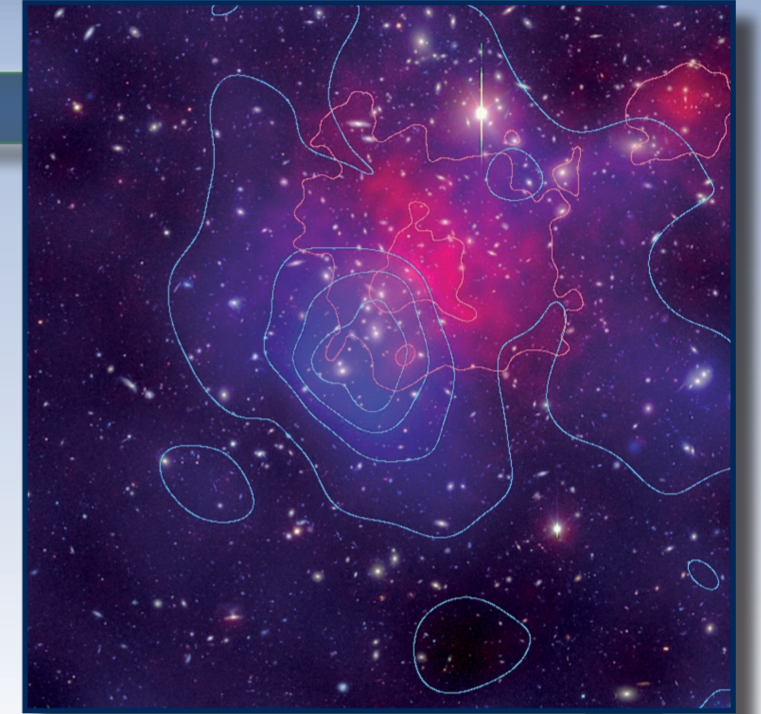

# International PhD program 2013 in Astronomy and Astrophysics



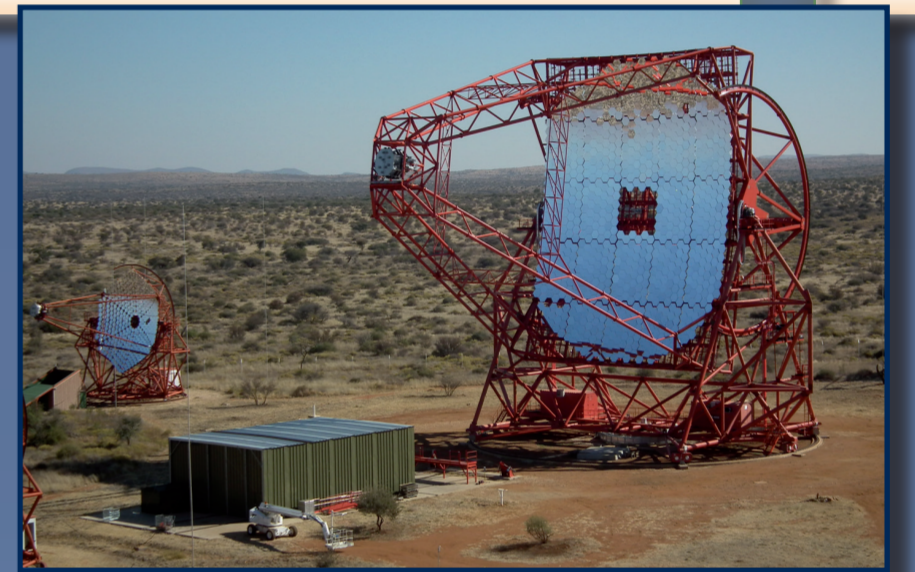
The IMPRS for Astronomy and Cosmic Physics (IMPRS-HD) offers several three-year doctoral fellowships starting summer/fall 2013.

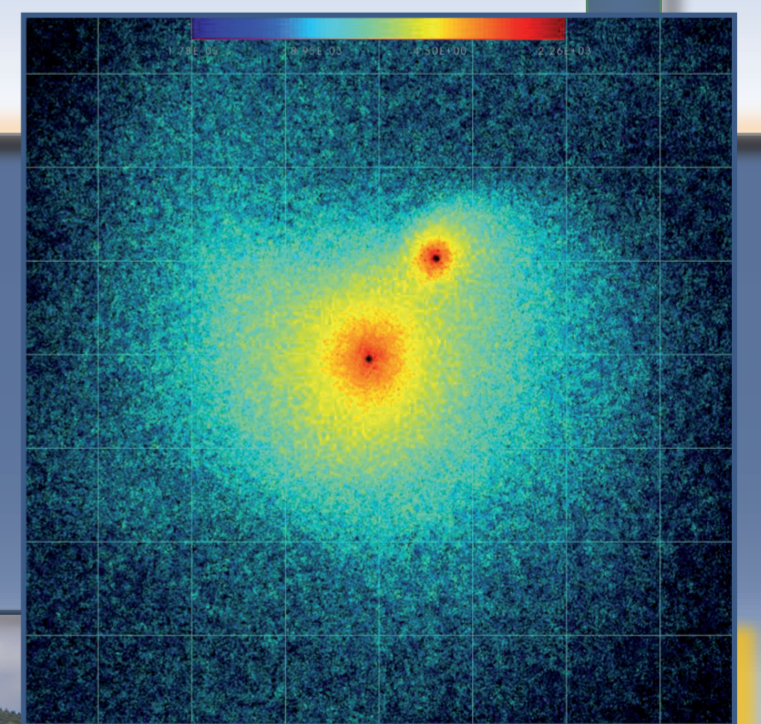
