IMPRS-HD is operated by six institutes of the Max Planck Society and the Zentrum für Astronomie of Heidelberg University:

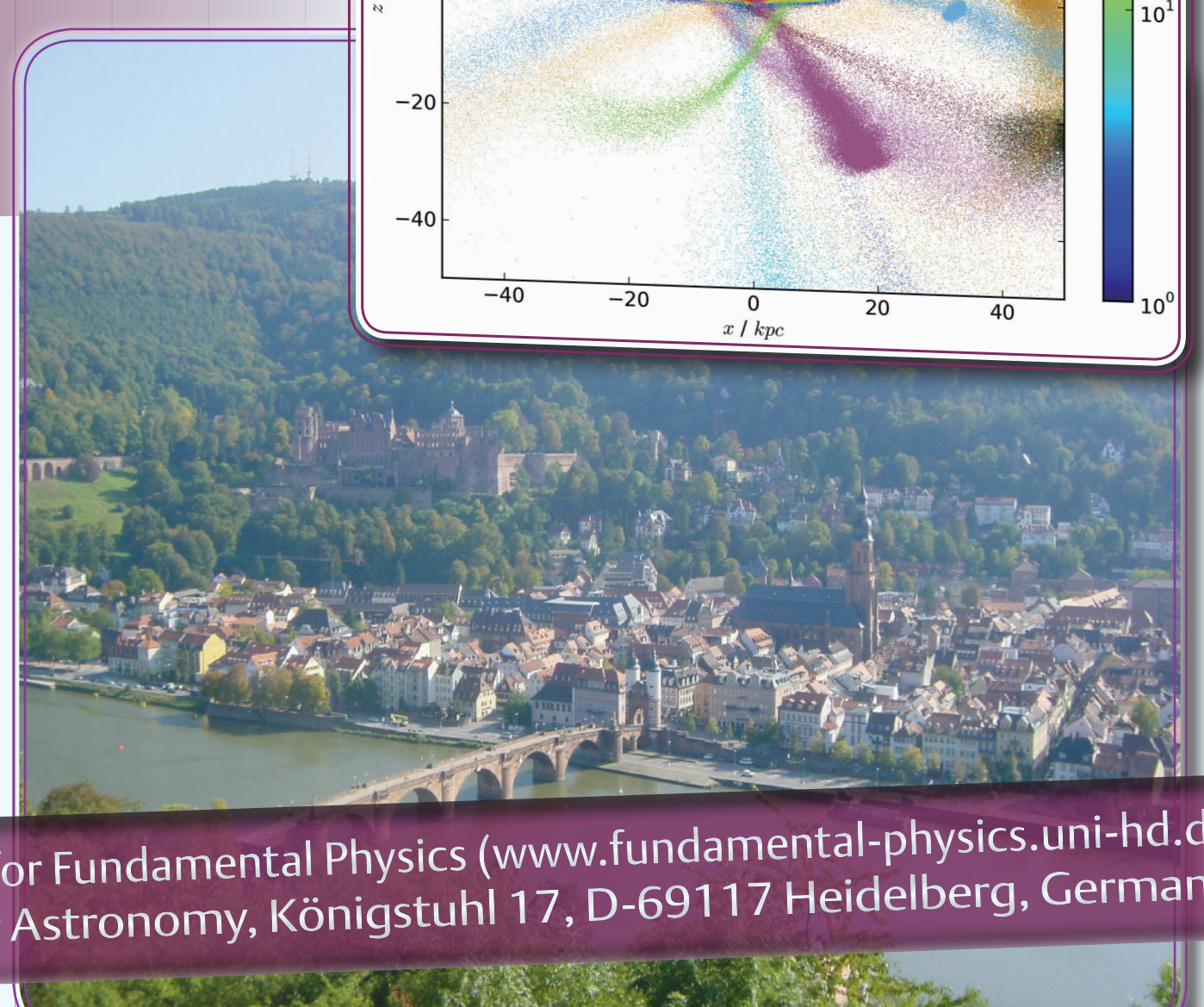
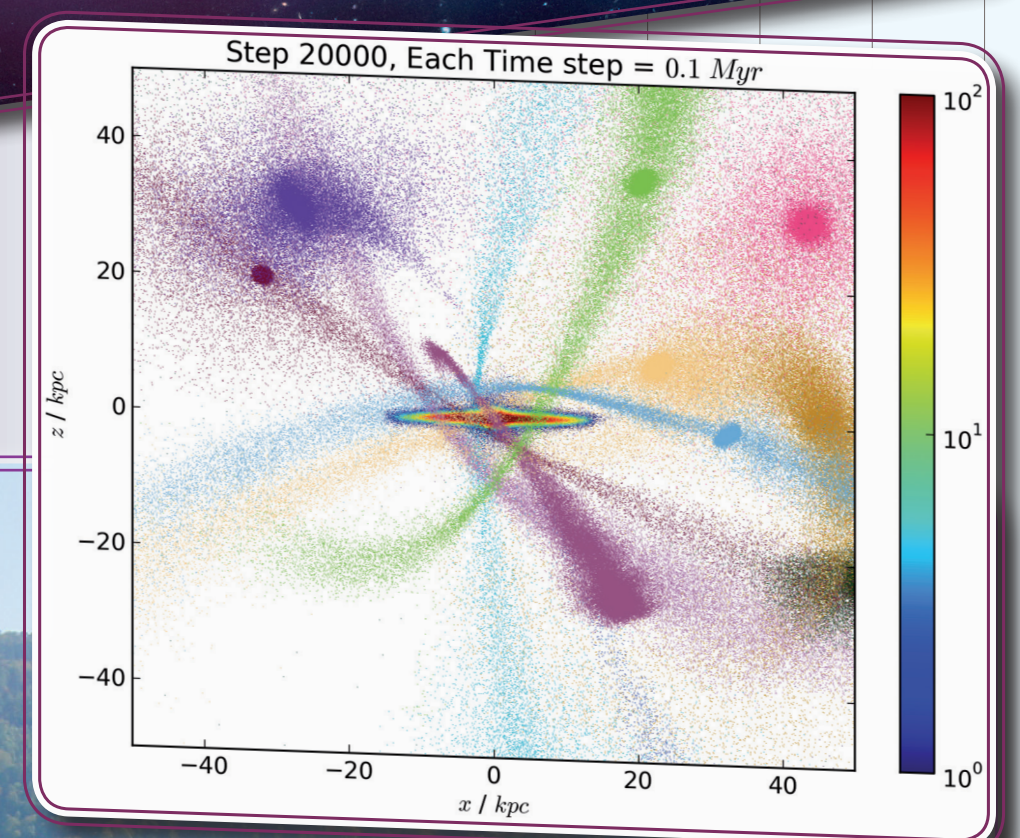
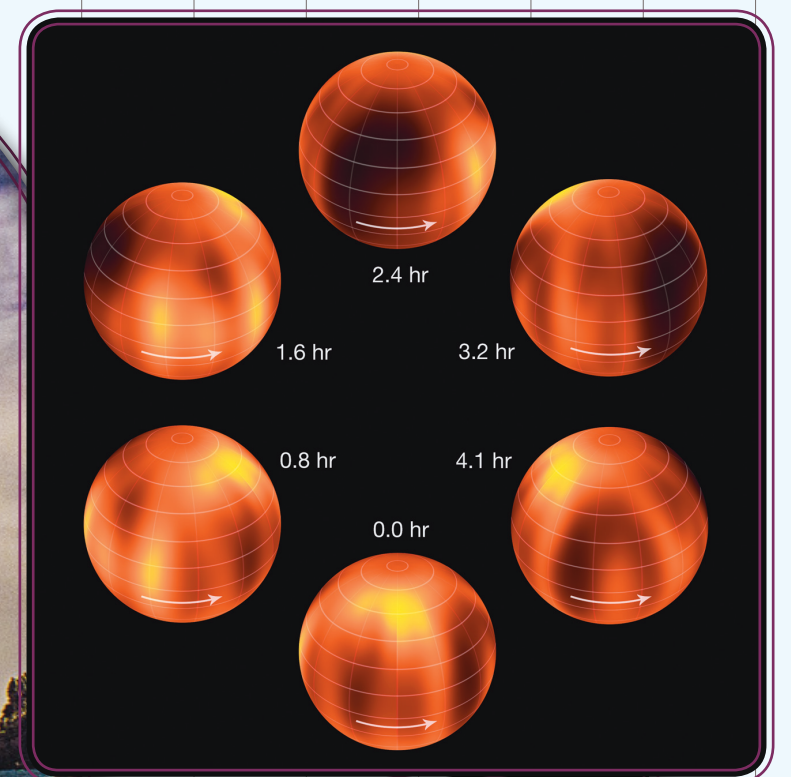
